

## **AD1150 Solar Powered Security Camera - SPSC**

The AD1150 Solar Powered Surveillance Camera is designed to be installed at any location that requires remote monitoring.

The AD1150 consists of a DLINK DCS-6513 camera with a weatherproof, vandal resistant housing, Pole, 240volt GPO & a 4G/3G modem for remote monitoring via the internet.

There are a number of options available such as battery backup to protect against power failure and also a full standalone solar powered option for applications where there is no mains power available.

The battery box is attached to the pole & houses the battery, solar regulator & 4G/3G modem. The system is designed for 24/7 operation and for use in Australia's harsh environment.

The camera provides real time video compression using MJPEG, MPEG-4 & H.264 codec's. The ePTZ (Electronic Pan, Tilt Zoom) option allows users to select a target region for close-up viewing simply by clicking on the video feed displayed with their browser. ePTZ makes use of the cameras megapixel resolution to survey a large area effortlessly. Since the ePTZ requires no moving parts, there is no need to worry about the mechanical lifestyle of the camera.

Footage can also be stored on a SD card enclosed in the camera & recorded footage can be reviewed remotely.
